

Many were stunned in early October of this year when EU parliament member Robert Roos of Holland asked Pfizer director Jeanine Small, "Was the Pfizer COVID vaccine tested on stopping the transmission of the virus before it entered the market?" ---to which Ms. Small stated an emphatic, "No!" After giving what could only be described as a chuckle, Small continued, "We had to really move at the speed of science to really understand what is taking place in the market." Whatever that means.

Never tested for transmission. Much of the world's population was shocked at such a casual admission. They felt betrayed and misled. In a statement reported by the New York Post, the CDC declared, "The evidence isn't clear whether they [the vaccinated] can spread the virus to others. We are continuing to evaluate the evidence."(3) Was Maddow just uninformed?

Did James Corden and Ariana Grande tell us that the COVID vaccines weren't tested for transmission as they sang their Broadway-esque tune "No Lock Downs Anymore," warbling about how the vaccine will make life possible again (we can get our hair cut, and even go to the movies!), while dancing a jig next to a giant picture of Fauci's face?

Did Stephen Colbert mention that the vaccines weren't tested for transmission as he cavorted with dancers dressed as syringes and gyrated his way through a parody of the oldie instrumental "Tequilla" called scene

"Vax-scene"?

Did Joe Biden indicate to the public that the COVID-19 vaccines weren't tested for transmission when he warned unvaccinated Americans that his "patience was getting thin?"

The examples go on and on. For over a year we were bombarded with propaganda, ads, and messages from our pop stars, celebrities, sober TV anchors, and even the president himself, telling, cajoling, persuading, and even demanding that we get one of the COVID-19 vaccines. It was possibly the most expensive and intense pressure campaign in U.S. history, bestowing virtue on those who complied, and then emboldening them to treat those who did not as enemies of society to be shunned and shamed. One column from the LA

Times was even titled, "Mocking anti-vaxxers death is ghoulish, yes---but may be necessary."

But wait, even though prevention of transmission was "Not

Required, Not Promised," (and not tested for), according to the Fact-Checkers, the COVID-19 vaccines actually DID prevent transmission. Surprise! Reuters presented two Lancet submissions and one of their own articles about a UK study as irrefutable proof that vaccines prevent transmission. Case closed. End of discussion.

Not quite. Firstly, the studies in question were limited, small in scope, and had various confounding factors. Secondly, to offset these studies, there are also correlative instances that work in the opposite direction. For example, a November 2021 article from Newsweek reported that,

"The five most vaccinated states in the United States—Vermont, Rhode Island, Maine, Connecticut, and Massachusetts—are all experiencing surges in new COVID-19 cases, as the Biden administration urges people over 50 to get their booster jabs."(4)

There was also a local article that came out in January of 2022 from KPTV.com titled, "Health officials: 2/3 of Multnomah County COVID cases are in vaccinated people." I had saved the link to this article, but the original has now been deleted----for whatever reason. (5)

One of the Lancet articles and the Reuters article about the UK study had both appeared in February of 2021. If these studies were definitive proof, why would the CDC be walking back Wolensky's claim that "vaccinated people do not carry the virus, do not get sick" in April 2021? Furthermore, in January 2022, The Maricopa health department in Arizona took down an ad claiming that the COVID-19 vaccines stopped transmission when they were legally challenged by the Informed Consent Action Network on the veracity of their claim. Additionally, in October 2022, a New York Supreme Court judge struck down New York's vaccine mandate, and in his ruling stated, "Being vaccinated does not prevent an individual from contracting or transmitting COVID-19." Both the Maricopa and New York examples demonstrate that the "evidence" for COVID-19 vaccines preventing the spread of the virus does not hold up in court.(6)

Recently, an article appeared in the Atlantic entitled, "Let's Declare a Pandemic Amnesty," in which the author urges that we should all forgive the "hard decisions" that were made during the COVID debacle

with the (incorrect) knowledge available at the time. I am willing to forgive any individual forced into making difficult or compromising decisions based on lies, but I am not willing to forgive a single individual

who knowingly spread those lies.

I am not willing to forgive, for example, Dr. Deborah Birx who admitted, "I knew these vaccines were not going to protect against infection. And I think we

If people hadn't challenged me to go on and do what I really didn't wish to do, I would still be in Alaska driving for a courier company. It's not a bad profession but it wasn't what I was called to do.

Called to do? What am I called to do?! This is the question that I hope to address and answer. What I am aware of is, when a person is in their right position there is no greater fulfillment--To know you are doing what you are called to do.

Peter in the Bible was a fisherman, he had his own business and did well. One day Jesus shows up, and this carpenter's son told this fisherman, "Cast your net to the other side in the deep." Peter most likely thought to himself, this is not how to fish. Instead, he listened and obeyed. Peter proceeded to pull in a catch that his boat could not contain. So large that he had to call to his partners to help haul it in. First,

Peter was willing to learn something new. But also, he was bold enough to try

what he had never done. So, in essence we have to sometimes do what we have never done; go where we have never gone; say what we have never said; and become who we have always wanted to be.

A King is to be a leader as well as a servant. There are many examples of this in The Word. Anytime a king ruled without being a servant there were problems within the kingdom.

The Priest (who is called to the fivefold ministry as mentioned in Gal. 4:11) is also a leader as well as a servant. These gifts run parallel to each other. When the priest is not serving spiritually but is in it for self-gain only, there were problems in the kingdom.

The solution is that we all find our position. Moses told God, 'I want to see your Glory' and in Exodus 33:22 (NIV) God said, "I will put you in the cleft of the rock". The rock is Jesus, and the cleft is our position. If we are in position, then we are doing what we should as a king or priest. You have a desire to see others prosper more than yourself. You are always there to give when the church asks of you. When we become givers without being receivers, we can feel used, and therefore can become users. What I mean is, we become wounded. When we become wounded then that we start reacting out of a fear to survive. All we see is how we are going to get hurt again, or worse die. So, we turn to fighting instead of trusting as love demands in 1 Cor.13. Love always trusts. If we can't trust, we will never know where we fit into the big picture of the Gospel.

We ask ourselves, 'How can I run a business and be a pastor, evangelist, teacher, prophet and apostle? I can't even make it to church every Sunday because I have a business!' This is where we have been out of balance and need correction. As a priest (a full-time minister earning a living from the gospel), my job is to make sure that there is a spiritual balance to everything.

It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ. Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of men in their deceitful scheming. Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will in all things grow up into him who is the Head, that is, Christ. From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows, and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work. (Eph 4:11-16 NIV)

Simply said, we as priests have not been doing our job. So, how can we expect others to follow? We have moved away from the true call, which is people! Getting them into the position God has called them to.

We, the priests, started constructing huge ministries or church buildings with selfish intentions and ambitions, to build our own kingdom and wonder why others are struggling. Not that big ministries are the problem; it's whether we are building His kingdom or ours; His vision or our vision; His strength or our insecurity. When we rely on our natural gifts to supply our vision, to build our kingdom, to cure our insecurity. The truth is, the natural is subject to the supernatural. Therefore, we must yield to what God wants. That is why we are here!

The role of the king, or the person that is Kingdom-minded in their business, is responsible for the Kingdom as well.

We all have different gifts, according to the grace given us. If a man's gift is prophesying, let him use it in proportion to his faith. If it is serving, let him serve; if it is teaching, let him teach; if it is encouraging, let him encourage; if it is contributing to the needs of others, let him give generously; if it is leadership, let him

govern diligently; if it is showing mercy, let him do it cheerfully. Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves. (Rom 12:6-10 NIV)

We see in this case that just as there is responsibility to a priest there is also a responsibility to a king. In this comparison I'm not saying that the kings are not giving or serving. We're needing to find the true balance of the Word of God.

Anytime there is to be reformation, people are not sure how to respond. On the other hand, others have been waiting for reformation. There must be a paradigm change in the way we think as the church and church leaders. The Kingdom of God is not a matter of talk, but power. It can no longer be our power--His kings or His priests can no longer hold the church captive.

Spiritual

How does this affect us spiritually? In every way we want to see the Kingdom of God advanced! We definitely can't do it with good looks! I know I've tried! So, the vision is blurred, and we lose focus of what is important. Let us see what Jesus was teaching here: "Listen! A farmer went out to sow his seed. As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants, so that they did not bear grain. Still other seed fell on good soil. It came up, grew and produced a crop, multiplying thirty, sixty, or even a hundred times." (Mark 4:3 NIV)

We can't keep sowing the seed in the first three categories; we must move onto good soil. I am talking in the context of giving, whether it is time, talents, or finances. This is the time to get into our right positions! When we are obedient to the Holy Spirit, then the spiritual takes care of itself, as well as the finances. The focus, therefore, is not on who has more money, or who prays more, or who has the larger ministry or the biggest church. It is a matter of are you in the right position? This not yet another plea for M.O.N.E.Y. It is simply a callinga beckoning, for everyone to get into the right position.

Change your Habits, Change your Life. One example is: The church is going on a mission trip and needs \$5,000.00. So, they go to the businesspeople of the church and ask for the finances to go on the mission trip. The businesspeople give them the money to go. But when it comes time to minister to the businesses and their families, as priests, we just haven't been there. There should be a consistency to minister to businesses and support them. This what I mean by position.

In the Old Testament when the king did not listen to the priest, as Saul did not listen to Samuel when God said kill every living thing! Instead, Saul spared the Amalekite king. At that point, the anointing that Saul had to be king over Israel was removed, and destruction came upon the kingdom because of the disobedience.

In the same way when the priests took advantage and ministered to the king, just to tickle his ears to fund their ministry, there was destruction in the kingdom.

But when there was honor between the two and unity of purpose, to see the kingdom expand and prosper there was peace and prosperity in the land! That principle is still at work today. There must be unity of purpose. Being in the right position: Knowing who we are and where our zone is, in the body of Christ.

Just simply doing "church" is not reaching the lost of the world. We have to be the church. The idea is all about position. If all of us are in our right position, then the Kingdom of God is going to prosper: Positionally, Spiritually and Financially.

It's not a matter of who gets what, or who knows who, it is all about what does the Holy Spirit want. Whenever you have reformation, you are always asked about your motives. 'What do you want?' and 'why?' are always the big questions. I would like answer that as simply as I can; I want the body of Christ to grow in strength and unity of the faith. I want to see souls won for the glory of Christ; the lame to walk, the blind to see, the dead to rise. Nations caught ablaze with the Glory and passion of Christ!

Vision is not the problem. As a pastor with an evangelist's heart, I have plenty of vision! I just can't fulfill this vision without kings and priest in my life. I also believe that the kings can't fulfill their vision without the priests in their lives as well.

We all desire the same thing regardless of the different flavor or brand of Christian that we are. What we want is for people to know and experience the freedom that we have every day of our lives from here to eternity. We want others to know the love and forgiveness that we have received. When this is the goal of the church then all simple differences are put to the side to accomplish the goal.

Position

Not always is a person able to give financially but they are able to help positionally. One example would be a person works for the airlines. They can acquire a cheaper airfare. Others have skills that will further along the Kingdom i.e., graphics, administration, networking, hospitality, cooking, transportation, and so on. This does not mean you have a lesser place in the kingdom. We

together. Not everyone is a priest or a businessperson; we all have our place in the function of the kingdom. Once again, we have to know our position in the body.

need all the gifts working

Now the body is not made up of one part but of many. If the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the

body," it would not for that reason cease to be part of the body. And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body," it would not for that reason cease to be part of the body. If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be? But in fact, God has arranged the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be. If they were all one part, where would the body be? As it is, there are many parts, but one body. The eye cannot say to the hand, "I don't need you!" And the head cannot say to the feet, "I don't need you!" On the contrary, those parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, and the parts that we think are less honorable we treat with special honor. And the parts that are unpresentable are treated with special modesty, while our presentable parts need no special treatment.

But God has combined the members of the body and has given greater honor to the parts that lacked it, so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other. If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honored, every part rejoices with it. Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it. (1 Cor 12:14-27 NIV)

We all want to be important; it is in our genetic make-up as humans. But what Paul is saying here is that every part is important. When there are too many of the same parts the body becomes defective. We all have to be in the place where God has called us. This is always the same dilemma; we all want to know what and where God has called us. We tend to make this more difficult than it really is. I believe it is because we think that if it is not huge and grand then we have failed God in some way. We must understand, Jesus only had twelve disciples, not millions, that he personally ministered to. He went after the big crowds evangelistically, but as far as disciples, it was only a few that really got it.

Even on the day of Pentecost, they started with about five hundred people in the upper room and ended with 120. It is not finding our place that is hard, it's sticking to it-staying obedient to that call. That is what is important. That we have the right relationship with one another, each knowing our position. Too many hands and no feet make it hard to travel and too many feet and no hands make it hard to work. So, there must be balance when it comes to people being in their right position.

Those that are called to preach must do so at any cost. Unfortunately, the cost has been at the expense of the gospel. If the priest did not have to worry about his or her next meal; or where they were going to live; or how they are going to get there; then they could preach the gospel without compromise.

If every time the doors of the church are opened, they would do better at honoring the

Kingdom by helping people to the positions that are called to- positionally, spiritual, financially.

Money is not just the only issue here; it is part of the equation but not the solution. The solution is everyone getting into their correct (divine) position, the rest will follow.

Paul mentioned that we should do what we are called to in 1 Cor 12. He was speaking about empowerment, when we are in the right position then we become empowered to do what we are called to do. When we are not in the right position then we feel lost and wandering. That is where the king and priest relationships begin to flourish, not taking advantage of each other but moving one another on to prosperity.

This prosperity that I am talking about is not just finances but are the three major focal points I have been talking about; positional, spiritual, and financial. I could go on and on about these subjects as you may have noticed!

I have talked a lot about position. There is a reason for this and that is because I think being in the right position is more important than the spiritual or financial. I'm sure you're asking why do you say that? Well, my answer is, show me any one of the first twelve disciples that were spiritual. They were not. But they were all in position; and Jesus knew that if they were willing to excel in their position, that they would step into the position that God had intended for them, then they would grow spiritually, and truly prosper. That is why I have pushed position so heavily.

So, in closing, the relationship between the kings and priests is this... The priests have the vision for the Kingdom and the kings have the Provision meaning this: Pro means for something, and Vision means the goal.

We have to stop giving just to the need because we are for the vision. GIVE TO THE VISION WHETHER KING OR PRIEST


